1. How many years must a mountain exist before it is washed to the sea?

Mountain erosion takes place over geologic timescales and can be influenced by a number of factors. However, assuming a steady erosion rate of 1mm/year, it would take Mount Everest — which currently stands at 8,848m — 88.5 million years to erode away to nothing.

2. Where have all the cowboys gone?

The number of working cowboys in America started to decline in the 1890s with the invention of barbed wire, which enabled farmers to keep cattle within designated zones and made long cattle drives unnecessary. However, the job is not completely obsolete. According to the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics, 9,730 people currently work as livestock handlers. Of these, 3,290 are listed in the subcategory of spectator sports, which includes rodeos and circuses.
